KVC provides a broad continuum of care that creates a path toward hope and healing through **crisis management, in-home therapy, skill-building, and connecting family needs with community resources.** Our family preservation programs aim to help families remain safely together, divert children from entering foster care whenever safely possible and improve family relationships. When reunification isn't an option, we connect children with loving forever families through adoption.

# We prevent child abuse & neglect.

Foster care provides a safe, nurturing environment that gives a child's birth family an opportunity to resolve conflicts and learn healthy skills so the child can safely return home. **KVC recruits, trains and supports compassionate adults to serve as foster parents.** These individuals ensure that children receive the nurturing, support and education they need to thrive, and play an important role in helping children recover from trauma and/or neglect.





## KVC Institute

- 1,300 Individuals received professional development and consultation outside of KVC staff
  - Completed 3-year commitment in Hennepin County, MN introducing and applying Safe & Connected™ practice model to multidisciplinary decision making, supervision and casework with children, older youth and families.
  - Continued partnership with Fairfax County, VA and Minnesota Prairie County Alliance, MN to implement Safe & Connected™ practice model and approach.
  - Partnered with The Annie E. Casey Foundation and the National Association of Social Workers (NASW) to provide strategic and content contributions to "Integrating Adolescent Brain Development Into Child Welfare Practice with Older Youth" curriculum, designed to train child welfare workers to incorporate a research-based understanding of adolescent brain development, trauma, resilience and healing into their practice. This curriculum was completed and is utilized in child welfare training academies across the country.






