
Foster care provides a safe, nurturing environment that gives a child's birth family an opportunity to resolve conflicts and learn healthy skills so the child can safely return home. **KVC recruits, trains and supports compassionate adults to serve as foster parents.** These individuals ensure that children receive the nurturing, support and education they need to thrive, and play an important role in helping children recover from trauma and/or neglect.



  Youth" curriculum, designed to train child welfare workers to
  incorporate a research-based understanding of adolescent brain
  development, trauma, resilience and healing into their practice.
  This curriculum was completed and is utilized in child welfare
  training academies across the country.




